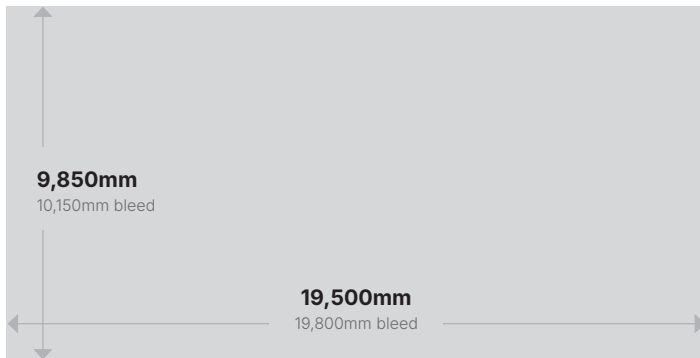

Production specifications



Artwork requirements

Finished size **19,500mm(w) x 9,850mm(h)**
Bleed size **19,800mm(w) x 10,150mm(h)**

All artwork to be supplied in CMYK as a **high res PDF** to visual size plus bleed.

1/10th scale, minimum 300dpi

The majority of applications used today will output a print ready PDF file. To make sure that your file is of the highest quality, all images should be set no lower than 300dpi resolution. Your file should also be created at 10% of the final size (If you prefer other formats such as 25 or 50% please make us aware of this with your order).

If using InDesign, export to PDF using the **press quality** setting with **crop marks** set at 10mm offset.

Finishing details

- Add 150mm border to all edges to allow for folding and securing to rear of frame
- Add 100mm internal safe zone, around all sides, within the visible artwork area
- Banner to be hemmed and eyeletted at 300mm centres (unless otherwise specified)
- Ensure any key artwork, logos, and text are positioned within the visible area to avoid obstruction by frame edges

Colour proofs

If colour proofs are to be supplied for colour matching, the proof must be generated from the file provided and be a true representation of the file. If a proof is not supplied then Ocean will not take any responsibility for colour inaccuracies.
